

In November 2024, 179 horse owners completed a survey about fireworks and equines. These are some of the findings:

56%
of horse owners say fireworks are frequently let off near to their horse

70%
report private firework displays are held close to their horse

95%
were not told that fireworks were going to be let off nearby

81%
of owners worry about the possible impact of fireworks on their horse

76%
take steps to try and protect their horse from fireworks

47%
know their horse was affected by fireworks on at least one occasion

Affected owners had experienced horses being:

- Distressed (65%)
- Injured/ill (21%)
- Escaped (8%)
- Killed (4%)



97%
of horse owners want more regulation around the use of fireworks

92%
say low-noise fireworks and other alternatives would benefit horse welfare
